Booth Information

Booth Categories

**Food Sales:** Any substances that can be consumed and are prepared on-site. Concession stands can set up the day before the feast and the day after the feast. **\*\* Food Handlers Card is required for each individual in the concession stands.**

**Novelty Sales:** Items that can include t-shirts, leather goods, games toys, music, etc. Snow cones, soft drinks, fruit drinks/vegetables, snack booths can be purchased under this category. **\*\* Streamers, spray paints, spray sticks, and bomb bags are not permitted to be sold.**

**Arts and Crafts:** any items made directly made by the individual selling. Baked goods can also be sold at craft booths.

## Rules & Regulations

The Pueblo de Cochiti Governor's office, with the support of the Tribal Council, require all vendors adhere to the following guidelines that promote a healthy environment for our youth, families and visitors.

*Please initial as acknowledgement of terms and conditions.*

\_\_\_\_\_ Pueblo de Cochiti has the right to refuse sale of a vendor permit to any individuals.

\_\_\_\_\_ Pueblo de Cochiti tribal members will NOT be allowed to sell during this time. (i.e. vending area or outside homes)

\_\_\_\_\_ Booth Space are on a first come first serve basis. ALL Native American vendors must provide a Tribal ID or Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB) at the time of booth purchase.

\_\_\_\_\_ Booths must be paid in full to reserve a space. This includes day of booth purchase (if available).

\_\_\_\_\_ Prices are subject to change without prior notice.

\_\_\_\_\_ All vendors are only allowed to sell in the designated areas. Sales are not allowed within the immediate area of the plaza.

**Vendors selling Novelty items:** Weapons, knives, disappearing ink, colored hair spray, fart spray, laser pointers, and any items that promote profanity, alcohol slogans smoking paraphernalia, or gang related items are **NOT ALLOWED**.

\_\_\_\_\_ **All FOOD BOOTH workers must have a valid Food Handlers permit.** Permits must be visible for the duration of the Feast Day. Indian Health Service representatives will be making rounds to inspect food booths, throughout the day. Food Vendors are responsible for the disposal of grease and gray water. Pueblo de Cochiti does not allow dumping on-site or on pueblo land.

\_\_\_\_\_ Vendors are responsible for all trash disposal, in the designated bins.

\_\_\_\_\_ **On Feast Day:** Vendors will be allowed to set up between 6am-9am.

\_\_\_\_\_ Prior to setting up, Vendors **MUST** check-in with the Registration Booth - located on Pumpkin St.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Vendors will not be allowed to set up after 9:00am. Unoccupied spaces will be sold after 9:00am.**

***For the duration of the feast day - VENDOR PERMITS MUST BE VISIBLE***

\_\_\_\_\_ Alcohol and Drugs are strictly prohibited on Pueblo de Cochiti lands.

\_\_\_\_\_ Picture taking, video recording, and/or sketching is prohibited. Devices are subject to confiscations and/or fines.

**NON-COMPLIANCE of these rules and guides lines will be subject to fines up to \$1000.00 and/or appearance in Pueblo de Cochiti Tribal Court.**

I have read and understand the vendor rules and regulations for the 2025 Pueblo de Cochiti Feast Day. By signing below, I acknowledge if I or anyone at my booth, violates any of the rules and regulations, we are subject to fines and/or will have to appear in Pueblo de Cochiti Tribal Court and may not be allowed to sell for future events.
